


## Safeguarding when school is closed



#### Lockdown Practice

In line with Safeguarding requirements, every school should hold regular fire drills and lockdown practices. We plan to carry out a lockdown practice next week in school. We will talk to the children in Collective Worship on Monday about this – this will be to reassure the children of what it means and what they and their class teacher will do during it e.g. draw the blinds in the classroom, lock the classroom door. The intention is to inform the children and make sure they feel comfortable and not to alarm them. We of course hope we will never need to use this procedure for real, however it is important that the children know what to expect.
