Homework

While we do not set structured and formal homework in Key Stage 1, it is important that skills and knowledge covered in class are recapped and consolidated at home. Each term, we will share a list of suggestions for homework activities. Any activities that are completed, please bring these in for us to show and celebrate in class!

- Reading (at least 5 minutes daily) parents, please record/log when you have heard your child read.
- Spelling Practise (including high frequency and common exception words)
- Number bonds to 10 and 20 (number facts to 100 too for Y2 children)
- Fluency with x2, x3, x5 and x10 tables
- Handwriting (cursive script)
- Write an alternative version and review for the book 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea'
- Create a leaflet/poster/fact file about the human body
- Carry out your own science investigations based on the human body e.g how long can you jump for?
- How many times does your heart beat in 1 minute?
- Visit a museum to look at how transport and vehicles have changed and evolved over time











