







Homework

While we do not set structured and formal homework in Key Stage 1, it is important that skills and knowledge covered in class are recapped and consolidated at home. Each term, we will share a list of suggestions for homework activities. Any activities that are completed, please bring these in for us to show and celebrate in class!

- Reading (at least 5 minutes daily) - parents, please record/log when you have heard your child read.
- Spelling Practise (including high frequency and common exception words)
- Number bonds to 10 and 20 (number facts to 100 too for Y2 children)
- Fluency with $\times 2$, $\times 3$, $\times 5$ and $\times 10$ tables
- Handwriting (cursive script)

- Research someone from History and create a fact file on them. You could bring this in to show!
- Write a recount or diary entry about your Christmas break.
- Create your own piece of Pablo Picasso artwork.
- What would you like to be when you grow up?
- Create a piece of artwork, a leaflet, fact file or presentation about habitats.
- Go on a shape hunt, record your findings.







Speed Sounds Set 2


