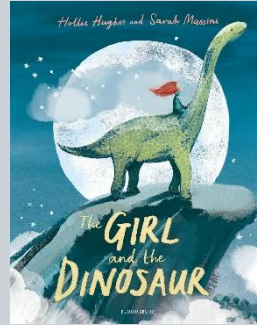

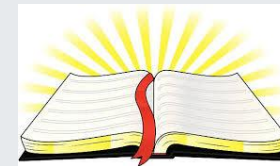

Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope you are all well and had a lovely Easter break! We are excited to welcome the children back for a new and engaging term in Cherry and Pine.

This term, our learning will be centred around the story *The Girl and the Dinosaur*. The children will enjoy exploring this imaginative text through storytelling, role play, and discussion. As part of our literacy learning, we will be focussing on developing the children's early writing skills this term. This will include practising writing simple words, labels and short sentences using their phonics knowledge. In our wider learning, the children will be learning all about dinosaurs and the pre-historic period, exploring different types of dinosaurs, learn new vocabulary, and engage in fun activities such as sorting, describing, and imaginative play.

In maths the children will be developing their understanding of counting accurately, recognising numbers, and exploring the composition of numbers (how numbers can be made in different ways). We will also be exploring number facts such as doubles and number bonds to support the children's mental maths skills.

As always, If you have any questions or would like to discuss your child's progress, please do not hesitate to speak to a member of the team!

A few reminders:

- Please ensure all of your child's belongings are clearly labelled.
- PE lessons will be on **Wednesday**. Please send your child into school dressed in their PE kit on this day.
