

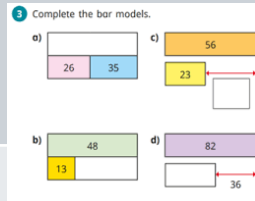

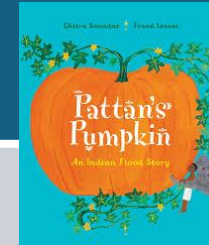

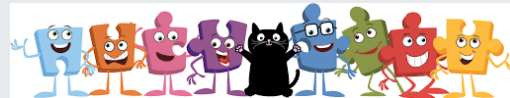

Dear Parents & Carers,

Welcome back to Term 5! We hope you all had a lovely break and are feeling refreshed and ready for the new term ahead. We have lots of exciting learning planned and are looking forward to a busy and enjoyable few weeks.

This term promises many engaging learning opportunities. In history, we will be learning about castles and the Royal Family, developing the children's understanding of life in the past and how it has changed over time. In art, we will be exploring natural art, using inspiration from the world around us to create our own pieces. In science, we are beginning an exciting new unit all about plants. The children will be growing their own plants, carefully observing changes over time, and sketching what they see as they watch their plants develop. In English, our text 'Patten Pumpkin' will focus on a story from another culture, helping to broaden the children's understanding of stories from around the world.

Please note that PE days have changed this term. In addition, the children will be going swimming every Wednesday, so please ensure your child brings their swimming kit each week. Further information is available via the school office.

As the weather gets warmer, please remember to send your child in with a water bottle, sun hat, sunglasses and sun cream to keep them safe and comfortable throughout the day.

Year 1 children will be preparing for their Phonics Screening Check, and Year 2 children will be preparing for their SATs, both taking place in June. More information regarding the timetable and arrangements will be shared with you soon.

Information regarding the Bourton on the Water trip was shared last term, and consent/payment is now available on ParentPay. Please contact the school office if you require any further information. I am also currently looking into another trip, which will most likely take place in July - more details to follow.

Homework

While we do not set structured and formal homework in Key Stage 1, it is important that skills and knowledge covered in class are recapped and consolidated at home. Each term, we will share a list of suggestions for homework activities. Any activities that are completed, please bring these in for us to show and celebrate in class!

- Reading (at least 5 minutes daily) - parents, please record/log when you have heard your child read.
- Spelling Practise (including high frequency and common exception words)
- Number bonds to 10 and 20 (number facts to 100 too for Y2 children)
- Fluency with x2, x3, x5 and x10 tables
- Handwriting (cursive script)

- Using natural materials, create your very own piece of natural artwork.
- Research and create a fact file about a particular plant.
- Read a variety of stories from other cultures.
- Y1 phonics screening and Y2 SATS preparation
- Grow your own seeds and bulbs - observe their growth.
- Visit a castle or something related to the royal family - write about it and share it with the class.

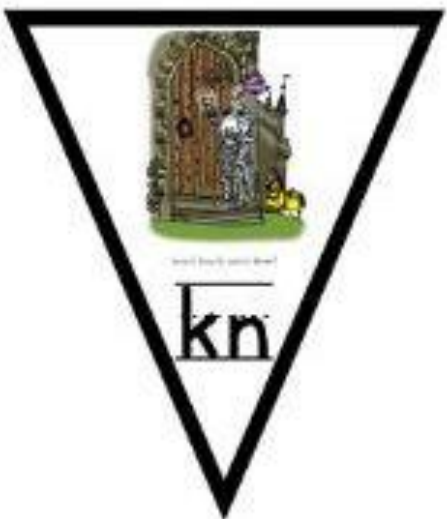
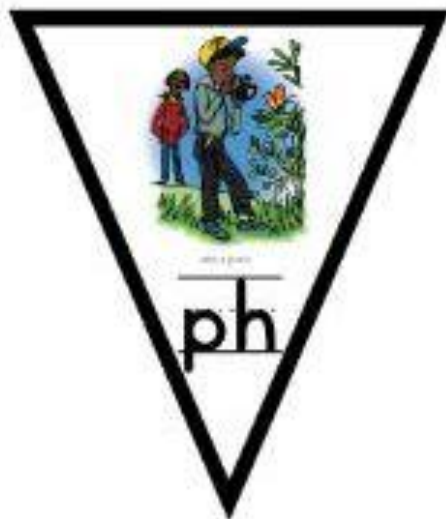
