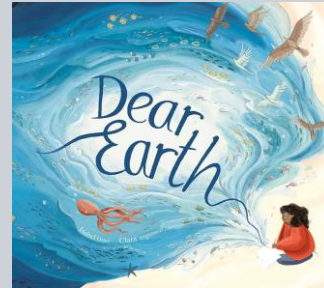

Welcome back for Term 6! We hope you had a lovely break and enjoyed some sunshine! This term, we are excited to begin our learning journey around the world as we explore the **seven continents** and discover the amazing places, people, animals, and environments that make our planet so unique. They will begin to learn the names of the seven continents and explore how each one is different. We will also be encouraging the children to make comparisons between their own environment and places around the world. A key focus for our topic will be the beautiful book "Dear Earth" by Isabel Otter. This story will support the children in thinking about how wonderful our planet is and how we can care for it. Through the book, we will explore themes of responsibility, respect, and appreciation for the natural world, encouraging the children to think about small actions they can take to help look after the Earth.

In maths, the children will be building on their number knowledge by developing a secure understanding of number bonds, helping them to recognise how numbers can be split and combined in different ways. They will also be working with numbers to 20 and beyond, strengthening their confidence in counting, recognising numerals, and beginning to solve simple problems.

We are looking forward to a fun and engaging term of discovery, where the children's curiosity about the world is encouraged and celebrated. We also welcome opportunities for you to support learning at home by talking about different places, sharing travel experiences, and exploring maps together.
